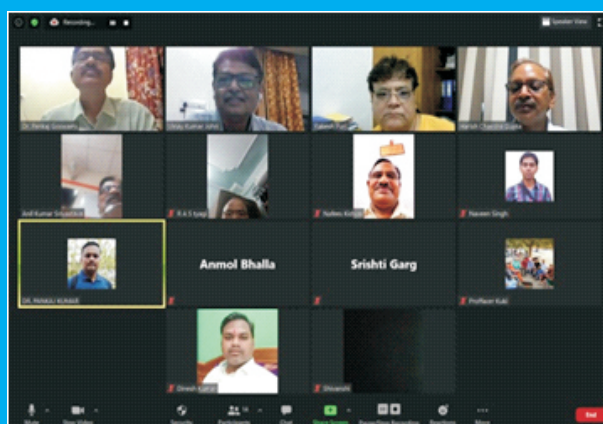
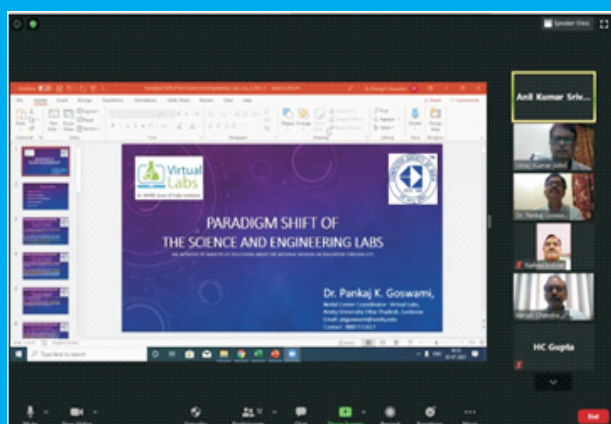

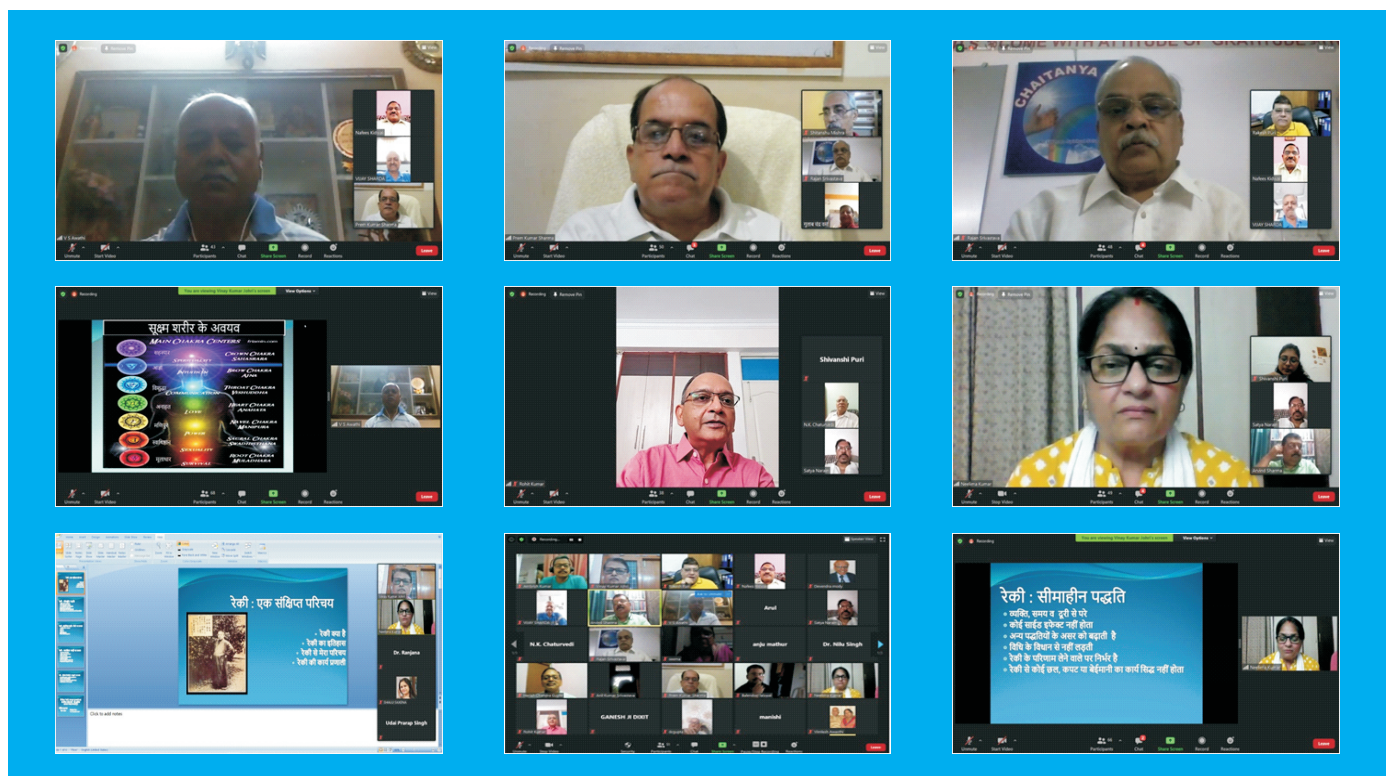
Mr. Vimlesh Awasthi Yog Teacher, Reiki Master and Magneto Therapist shared about the Main Chakras Energy Centres and their effects.

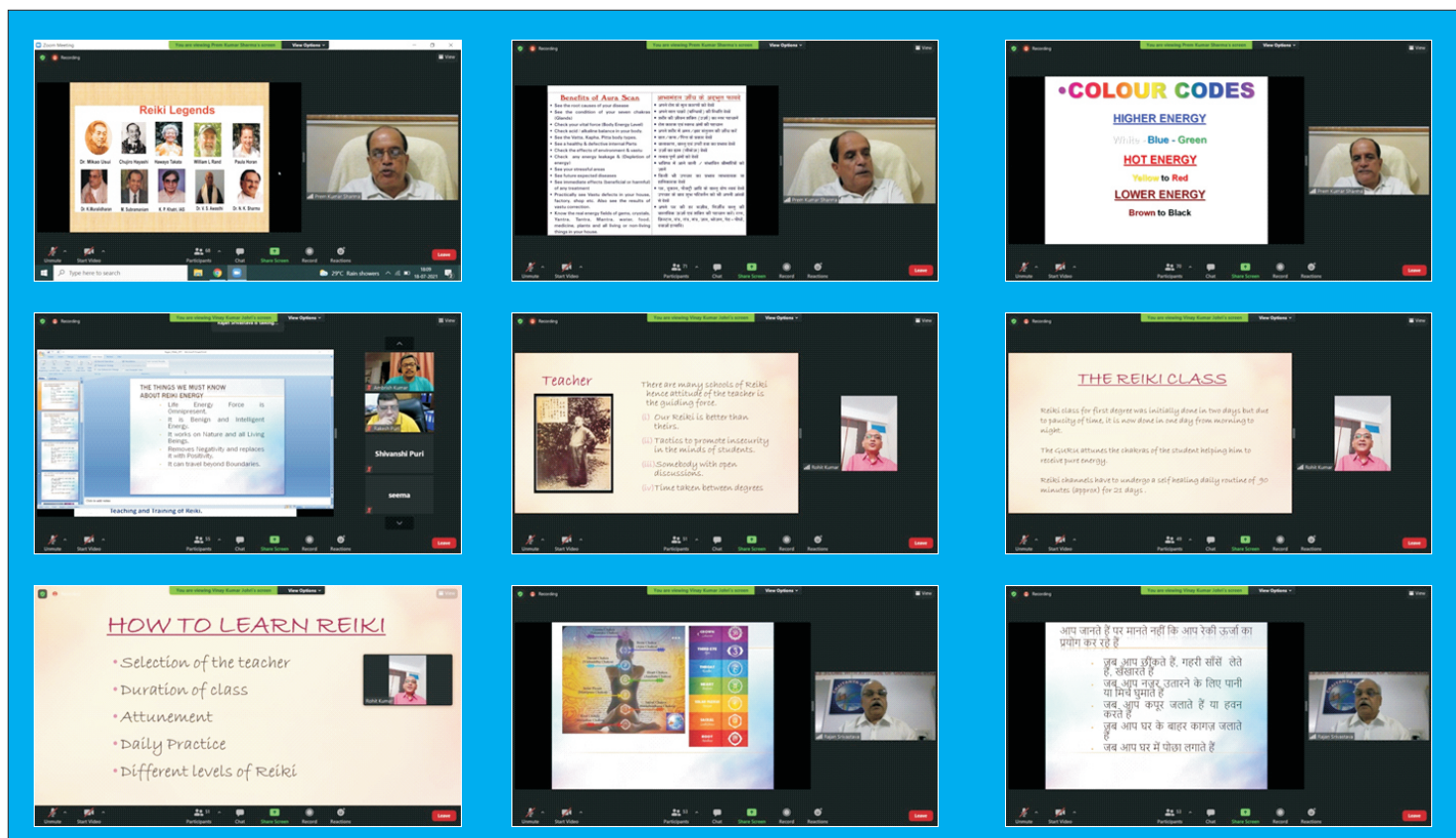
