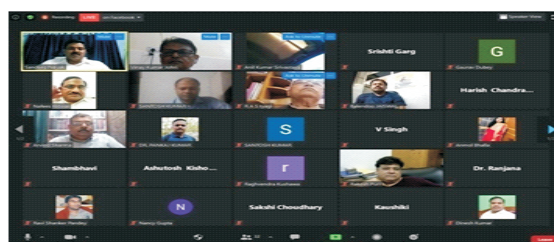
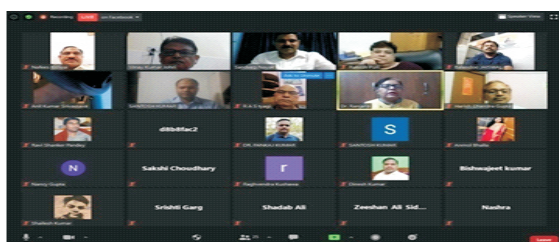
The Moderator of the Webinar Dr. Santosh Kumar started the proceedings of the Webinar.
